ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

4Delivery operates within the water and construction industries in the fields of design, construction and commissioning. 4Delivery recognises its responsibility to effectively manage our key environmental issues through the development and implementation of processes and procedures, which also enable us to effectively support the development objectives of our key stakeholders. We are cognisant of our major environmental impacts and recognise how our activities interact with the communities in which we operate.

The 4Delivery Board endorses, fully supports and will resource this Policy, and is committed to continual improvement in the operation and management of our activities that could impact upon the environment. This policy will be regularly reviewed and made available to all staff and to other stakeholders upon request.

4Delivery will achieve these aims by:

- Improving, promoting and actively encouraging an environmentally responsible holistic "life cycle" approach to the various phases of development and to propose sustainable alternatives where possible and positive benefits can be derived;
- Appreciating and complying with legislation as a minimum and any other requirements governing our work activities, additional client requirements and approved codes of practice as appropriate;
- Identifying and evaluating the environmental aspects of all projects which the company engages in, which shall enable us to target issues such as waste reduction, air quality, ground conditions, water courses and the prevention of pollution;
- Establishing environmental objectives that are realistic and achievable and set environmental targets for improvements to our business. These shall be reviewed regularly by Management to ensure they accurately reflect our overall business strategy;
- Identifying the training needs of all our employees, subcontractors and suppliers and delivering the appropriate level and frequency of training to promote environmental awareness and best practice and thus engender a common culture of understanding as to the environmental impacts of our activities;
- Encouraging 4Delivery principal supply chain partners to adopt appropriate levels of environmental management to support the company objectives; 4Delivery shall communicate this policy to its key stakeholders to set the direction and principles by which we and our supply chain shall operate;
- Sourcing environmentally sustainable materials, reducing our consumption of energy and raw materials and maximising the opportunities presented to 4Delivery to re-use and recycle, where feasible;
- Operating a certified environmental management system in accordance with the recognised international standard ISO14001.

4Delivery's philosophy is to develop a business at the forefront of best practice in the UK Water and Construction sectors, where the economic, environmental and social aspects of our business activities are managed to minimise our impacts whilst maximising our opportunities to contribute to the sustainable development of the communities in which we operate.
